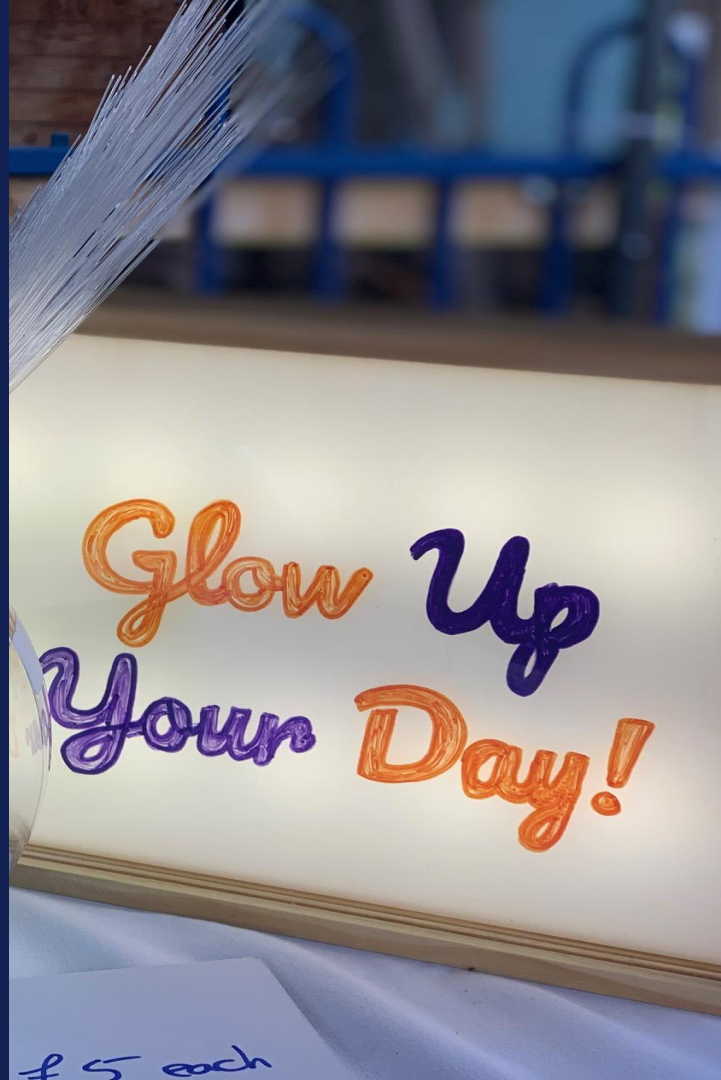

Introduction to the Belmont PTA

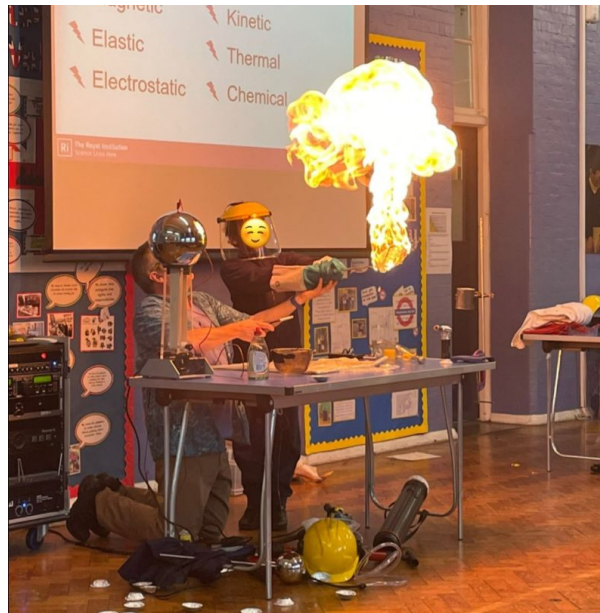
We are a **registered charity** (Belmont Home School Association, BHSA) with 2 main aims:

We organise events that bring the community together, encourage parents & carers to volunteer their time to the school and support class reps



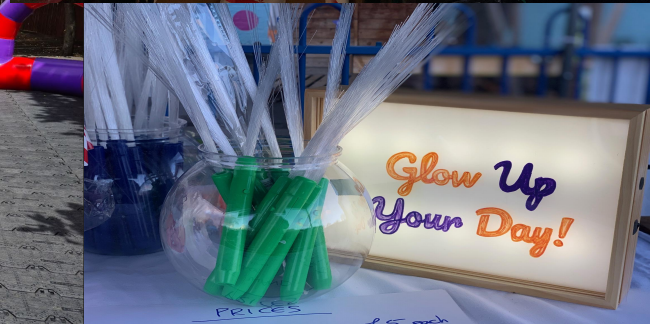

- Communicate messages and news from the class teacher to class/year group
- Publicise events and encourage parents/carers to get involved and sign up to Classlist
- Attend PTA Forums and the AGM and cascade relevant information to your class/year groups
- Organise and run your year's stall at the Christmas and Summer Fair (alongside class volunteers)
- Coordinate Christmas and end of year cards and **voluntary donations** for teachers
- Organise parent/carer social events for your year (ideally once per term)
- Recruit next years reps

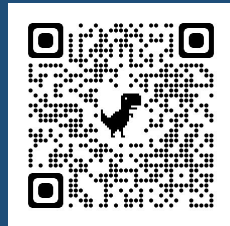

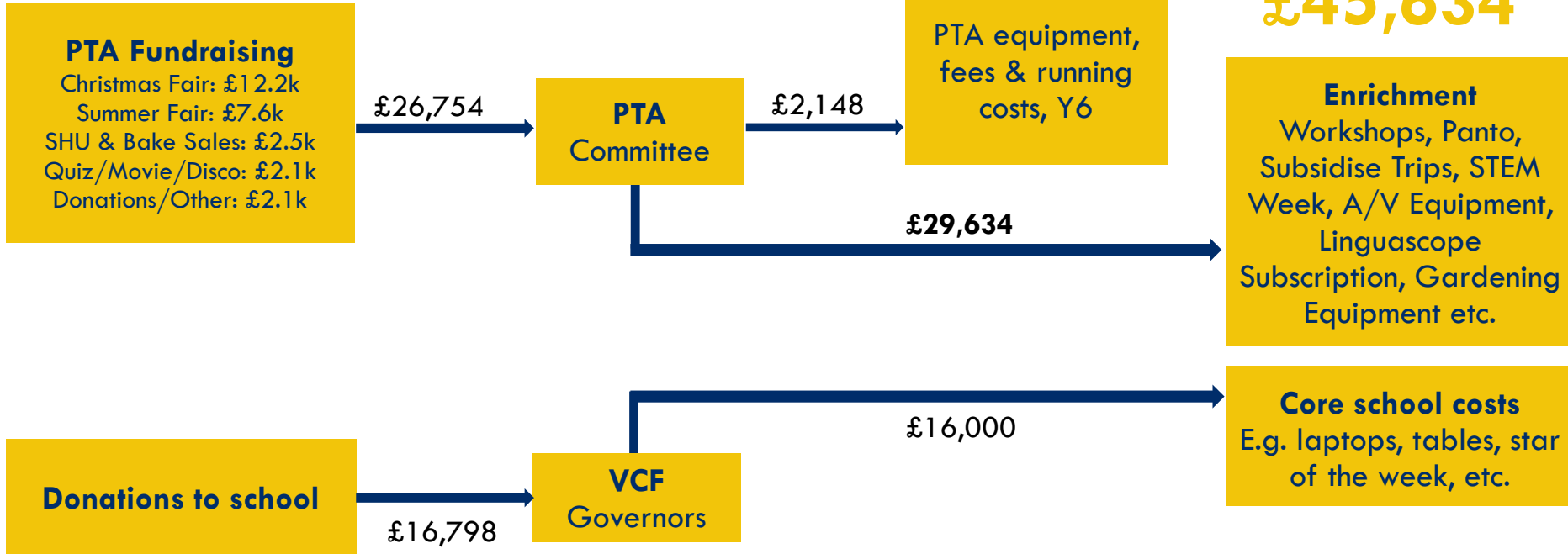
